## Socratic Seminar Questions: GROUP B

## **EXAMPLE/FORMAT:**

1. How has Transcendentalism impacted your life?

RESPONSE: Transcendentalism has helped me become more self-aware. Prior to this unit I felt like I was merely coasting through life, without really taking the time for self-reflection, much less taking time to change the things I realized I needed to change because of my time spent engaged in self-reflection. This unit has taught me about the importance of taking time for solitude, and how that's really the only way we can come to discover who we truly are. We are so heavily influenced by things that are not reflections of who we are, yet we follow along because of societal pressure. I've made a commitment to embark on the journey to greater self-discovery by deliberately and regularly spending time alone in nature.

- 5. "NEVER LOOK BACK UNLESS YOU ARE PLANNING TO GO THAT WAY." IS LOOKING BACK REALLY A DETRIMENT OR STUMBLING BLOCK TO AN INDIVIDUAL? WHAT WOULD THOREAU SAY ABOUT THE MERIT OF LEARNING FROM OUR PAST EXPERIENCES BASED ON THIS QUOTE?
- 6. IS IT POSSIBLE TO EMBRACE SIMPLICITY AND STILL ENJOY THE MODERN-DAY LUXURIES OF LIFE?
- 7. "IT IS EASY IN THE WORLD TO LIVE AFTER THE WORLD'S OPINION; IT IS EASY IN SOLITUDE TO LIVE AFTER OUR OWN; BUT THE GREAT MAN IS HE WHO IN THE MIDST OF THE CROWD KEEPS WITH PERFECT SWEETNESS THE INDEPENDENCE OF SOLITUDE."
